1.2 Summary

A simple module which mimics the *reader* classes from python's *csv* module but returns an object whose attributes are the members of the header instead of a list or dict.

The *ObjectReader* also provides a way to make fields required to be present and required to be not empty.

Installation

At the command line:

```
$ easy_install csv_object_reader
```

Or, if you have virtualenvwrapper installed:

```
$ mkvirtualenv csv_object_reader  
$ pip install csv_object_reader
```

Usage

To use `csv_object_reader` in a project:

```
import csv_object_reader
with open("somefile.csv") as f:
    reader = csv_object_reader.ObjectReader(f)
    for line in reader:
        print(line)
```
